INTRODUCTION

The Pakistan Mineral Development Corporation (PMDC) has launched an enriching internship program aimed at providing final-year students with practical experience in their respective fields. This initiative underscores PMDC's commitment to fostering professional development and nurturing future leaders in various sectors including Mining, Geology, HR, Finance, and Legal.

PROGRAM ANNOUNCEMENT AND APPLICATION PROCESS

The internship program was officially advertised on the PMDC website on July 14, 2024. PMDC also reached out to universities and colleges, inviting them to nominate eligible candidates. The response was overwhelming, with numerous applications received across various disciplines. The program is designed for final-year students with a minimum CGPA of 3.0, ensuring that only the most capable and dedicated students are considered. The internship period spans two months, offering a stipend of Rs. 25,000 per month.



APPLICATION STATISTICS AND SELECTION

The response to the internship program was significant:

- Mining: 22 applications received, 9 shortlisted.
- Geology: 110 applications received, 10 shortlisted.
- HR: 10 applications received, no eligible candidate found.
- Finance & Account: 6 applications received, no eligible candidate found.
- LLB: 2 applications received, 1 shortlisted.



After a rigorous selection process based on merit which was calculated on defined percentage of their qualifications starting from matric to Graduation/Masters, the top candidates were chosen:

- 4 geologists
- 4 mining engineers
- 1 legal student
