




# Major Achievements in Mining Operations.



## Development of two new Coal Mines at the PMDC Collieries Sor-Range Project


Engr. Asad Ahmad, CEO/Managing Director of Pakistan Mineral Development Corporation (PMDC), inaugurated two new coal mines at the PMDC Collieries Sor-Range Project. This marks a significant achievement, as it is the first new coal mines project since the inception of PMDC

The coal seam in the Sor-Range area has been observed to vary between 4 and 22 feet in thickness, with current operations successfully excavating up to 7 feet. To enhance productivity and optimize resource recovery, PMDC management has outlined a strategic plan to expand mining operations.

### Expansion Strategy:

1. Phase 1: Development of two new mines in the south-east area, with operations already initiated.
2. Phase 2: Following the successful extraction of coal from the south-east mines, two additional mines will be developed in the north-west.

This phased approach underscores PMDC's commitment to maximizing coal extraction while ensuring the sustainable development of resources in the Sor-Range region.



## Development of New Model mine at PMDC Salt Mines Khewra

On December 5, 2024, Engr. Asad Ahmad, CEO/Managing Director, PMDC inaugurated the Western Hill Model Mine at the PMDC Salt Mines in Khewra, marking a key milestone in PMDC's progress under his leadership.

He also inaugurated the pilot project of Grinding plant Which is an initiative towards value addition of rock salt at Salt Mines Khewra .




The mine's first phase began with a capital expenditure (CAPEX) of 20 million and is expected to produce 200,000 metric tons (MT) of salt in the financial year 2026-27 , with a payback period of three years. It will meet international mining and HSE standards.



The CEO/Managing Director of PMDC also visited educational institutions operating under the CSR initiatives of Pakistan Mineral Development Corporation. Under his leadership, PMDC is poised for continued growth and excellence.

## Tourist Attraction: Wonders Inside The Mine

The Khewra Salt Mines, is a major tourist attraction in Pakistan. Large number of tourists visit Khewra Salt Mines each year, driven by curiosity and their instinct for a unique adventure. The CEO/Managing Director, PMDC inaugurated new facilities in the visiting area of the Khewra Salt Mines, developed to enhance tourist attractions.



## Acquisition of two (2) Large Scale Exploration Licenses for Metalloids & Precious Mineral (antimony)

PMDC has been granted two exploration licenses by the Government of Balochistan for the exploration of metalloids and precious minerals, particularly focusing on antimony in the regions of District Pishin and District Zhob. These licenses cover two distinct blocks, which are situated at key mineral-rich areas of Balochistan.

Both areas are strategically important for the exploration of metalloids and precious metals, with a particular focus on antimony. These metals are crucial for various industrial applications, making the exploration a highly significant endeavor for both local and international markets.

PMDC is committed to adhering to international exploration standards, particularly the NI 43-101 guidelines and the stage gate concept. This ensures a rigorous, systematic approach to the exploration and evaluation of the areas. As part of the exploration process, PMDC has already conducted a hyperspectral study over an area of 10,000 sq. km across both Zhob and Pishin districts. This study was carried out using Advanced Hyperspectral Sensor Imaging (AHSI) from the ZY1E Satellite, covering 166 spectral bands, as well as VNIR (Visible and Near-Infrared Camera), which analyzed 8 bands. The study successfully mapped and targeted antimony deposits, which are of primary interest.

This exploration project has the potential to significantly contribute to the economic growth of Balochistan and Pakistan, leveraging the region's rich natural resources in metalloids and precious metals, with a particular emphasis on antimony.



## Signing of Joint Venture agreement with Miracle Salt Collective Inc. USA for Pink Rock Salt Crushing Packaging & Export

Pakistan Mineral Development Corporation (PMDC) and Miracle Saltworks Collective Inc. (MSCI) Wisconsin, USA signed a JV Agreement to set-up State of the Art Pink Rock Salt Crushing and Packaging facility for Export on 10th August ,2023 at Islamabad.



The plant will be set up at Special Economic Zone located in the District Mianwali, Punjab, Pakistan. The production capacity of the Plant is 150,000 tons per annum and total FDI is USD 200 Million.

By harnessing state of the art technology and best practices in the industry, the initiative aims to position Pakistan as a prominent player in the global Pink Rock Salt market. This endeavor is expected to not only bolster economic growth but also cast a spotlight on the nation's unique Pink Rock Salt on the international stage.

## MoU signed with Sapphire Chemicals for setting up of State-of-the-Art Soda Ash Plant

PMDC and Sapphire Chemicals (Private) Limited signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on the 3rd of October, 2024 at Islamabad to establish a State-Of-The-Art Soda Ash Plant. The capital cost of this plant is USD 163 million.



The envisioned plant will be set up near PMDC Salt Project, District Khushab, Punjab. The production capacity of soda ash plant will be around 200,000 ton per annum, contributing to the market requirements of Pakistan as well as regional demands. PMDC will supply 360K tons per annum industrial quality rock salt to Sapphire Chemicals by following international standards for mechanized mining.

This Soda Ash Plant will not only boost Soda Ash industry, but also provide job opportunities to the locals of the areas. The project will also attract foreign investment, thus contributing with the economic growth of Pakistan.

## MoU signed with Geological Survey of Pakistan for sustainable mining practices in Pakistan

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the Geological Survey of Pakistan (GSP) and Pakistan Mineral Development Corporation (PMDC) is a strategic initiative aimed at enhancing mineral exploration, resource evaluation, and sustainable mining practices in Pakistan. By leveraging GSP's geological expertise and PMDC's operational experience, this collaboration seeks to identify, assess, and optimize mineral resources across the country. The partnership will facilitate advanced geological studies, mineral testing, and database development, attracting local and foreign investment to the mining sector. Additionally, the agreement promotes technological advancements, research, and training programs, ensuring the adoption of modern, efficient, and environmentally responsible mining techniques. It also encourages joint ventures with national and international organizations, fostering global engagement and knowledge exchange. With a focus on economic growth, employment generation, and sustainable resource utilization, this MoU positions Pakistan to strengthen its mineral industry and unlock its vast natural resource potential for long-term development.



## MoU signed with OGDCL for Exploration in Gilgit Baltistan

PMDC signed MoU with Oil & Gas Development Company Limited (OGDCL) for collaboration in the mining sector of Pakistan. This collaboration establishes a framework for negotiation on the joint venture and business development opportunities in the upstream, midstream and downstream segments of mining sector/ industry with an aim to explore & develop the indigenous mineral resources in line with international best practices.



To ensure effective implementation, a Joint Working Group (JWG) has been constituted. The JWG will oversee all the matters related to Joint working including coordination among the parties for mutually agreed decision. The JWG will focus on the identification and techno commercial assessment of business opportunities. Presently, Both the parties are in negotiations phase and have identified several promising prospects including gold, precious & base metals and metalloid for joint working in Gilgit Baltistan, Baluchistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa based on PMDC exploration data. The parties are anticipated to enter into a comprehensive JV agreement in the near future.

## MoU signed with Hub Pak Salt Refinery for advance pink rock salt processing and exports

To unlock Pakistan's vast pink rock salt potential, PMDC and Hub Pak Salt Refinery have signed an MoU for a \$23 million investment to advance pink rock salt processing and exports. This MoU sets the stage for a technologically advanced manufacturing setup, aimed at transforming raw salt into premium, value-added products for international markets. With a focus on quality enhancement and global competitiveness, this collaboration is expected to elevate Pakistan's standing in the mineral export sector while fostering industrial growth and economic sustainability.



Under this agreement, PMDC will supply rock salt on a non-exclusive commercial basis, while Hub Salt will lead the installation of processing facilities, sales, marketing, and exports. The project also includes plans for modernizing mining techniques, ensuring food-grade salt production, and developing a skilled workforce through a dedicated training institute. Additionally, CSR initiatives, such as community development, health programs, and women empowerment, will contribute to sustainable growth in the operational areas.

This strategic move aligns with PMDC's commitment to nurturing the next generation of leaders and professionals in the mineral development sector.




